#### Cancellation: online courses

Cancellation: in person courses and events

If you need to cancel your booked place, please email <u>education@bathwells.anglican.org</u> 100% charge of full course fee will be charged if the cancellation is 3 working days (or below) or you do not attend.

This may happen where an insufficient number of delegates have booked onto the course, or because we are unable to deliver the course for some other reason.
