Pray, dream, consult, and devise a bespoke role for a fully funded local pioneer. Four posts have been approved, three pioneers appointed. More posts are available that your deanery could bid for. Ideas must focus either on mission among young people, or in areas of new housing, or areas of deprivation.

Specialised Hubs

Come to one of our open Hub events and find out about Messy, Café and Outdoor Church. Bring and share your ideas, experiences and questions. Messy and Café Hubs are up and running. Outdoor Church and New Housing Hubs start soon.

Certificate in Pioneer Mission

Join a new year-long course of six modules to help people who have a call from God share the gospel in culturally appropriate ways. Mission spirituality, Bible in context, pioneering in the rural church, missional church and reflective practice are some of the topics covered over six weekends bi-monthly.

Mission-shaped Ministry

For teams of people from a church or group of churches who want to equip themselves in mission and think about how to listen, serve and love their community open to the prompting of the Spirit. The course is tailored to your own needs and context.

Pioneer Hotspots

A 'Hotspot' is an open gathering of people who are having a go at pioneering or thinking about starting. People share ideas, ask questions and encourage each other. Hotspots meet in Portishead, Frome, Locking, Bath and Shepton Mallet/Glastonbury deaneries. The Taunton Hotspot meets first in April.
