Training update

These take place in person at Flourish House, Wells and are suitable for both new and existing PSOs on 15 December and 5 January via our website.

Appeal for volunteers to deliver face to face Basic Awareness and Foundation Training

Due to current financial pressures I'm not in a position where I can increase staffing and as such, over the course of this last year, used volunteers to provide Basic and Foundation as an in-person session. If you have done this previously and are willing to support us again please could you let me know as soon as possible?
